I hope everyone saw the letter that was posted yesterday with a few reminders for parents. We are finding it particularly challenging when they are lining up to go anywhere – coming in, going in/out for recess and lunch, etc. you helping to remind them at home as well would help.

We greatly appreciate your cooperation with maintaining social distancing and mask wearing on the school grounds as much as possible as well. We know that some of these things just need reminders for everyone – children and adults and that's why we send out messages every now and then. I am also anticipating further direction from the PHO next week in light of recent case numbers. I'm sure there will be more information/reminders coming from the school!
