# Principal's Message

Dear Stoney Creek Families:



Welcome to the beautiful colors of Fall! Some of the trees sure have been displaying some wonderfully colourful leaves of late. Hopefully we will have some more sunny days to enjoy the last of them before they finally fall off. Hallowe'en festivities have been happening here lately. Thanks so much to our parent volunteers for making our Pumpkin Patch a reality a week ago. Our Primary students really enjoyed the experience of 'choosing' their pumpkin from the patch that Division 4 and 5 students created for them in the grotto. Many of the students also used their pumpkins to learn from in creative ways throughout the week. There has also been some great Hallowe'en art

displayed throughout the school the past few weeks. Please enjoy some of the photos at the end of the newsletter as well as what we have posted on Twitter.

A big thank you to our parent volunteers who helped with the new <u>Stream of Dreams</u> installation of our fish on the tennis courts fence. This was a wonderful project that all students and staff had the opportunity to participate in. We are so grateful to the Stream of Dreams organization for providing us with this wonderful learning opportunity. It has also totally revitalized our fence with all of the vibrant colours and it looks fantastic. We have included some pictures, but if you haven't had a chance to see it in person, you really should go and check it out.

Most of our grade 4 and 7 students have completed writing the FSA tests. Completion will be by mid-November. Tests will then be marked and returned home to families. These are annual tests written by grade 4 and 7 students throughout the province to assess basic Literacy and Numeracy skills. Once the tests have been marked in mid-November, booklets will be returned to parents.

Parents can expect to see an Interim Report for their child at the end of this month. Interims can take various forms – this could include a written template, a phone/video conference with the teacher, a blogfolio entry, etc. Whatever form of interim reporting your child's teacher chooses to engage in, we hope that you will take an active part as well, as we believe that parents play an integral role in the education process. Education is a partnership between home and school and your involvement helps ensure success for your child. Open and ongoing communication with your child's teacher is crucial. We appreciate and welcome your input.

As we continue to navigate through the pandemic, I feel the need for a few reminders to families and students. We are noticing that some of the health procedures that need the support of parents are not being followed consistently. Students continue to arrive at school without masks and without having had their Daily Health Check completed by a parent/guardian prior to their arrival. Both of these are required for all students in grades K – 7 and have been required for some time now. We need your cooperation with this, please. Also, in case you are not aware, the procedure for reporting cases is different this year from last. Please refer to the Fraser Health website for more information on School Exposures. We continue with daily handwashing routines, staggered start and end times, and designated play areas in an effort to keep students safe.

# Principal's Message (Cont'd)

I am happy to report that we do have the return of some student activities here at Stoney Creek. We have volleyball underway for our grade 6 and 7 students and two lunchtime clubs have started in the last couple of weeks – a Ukulele Club and a Dungeons and Dragons Club. Students are enjoying these lunchtime activities run by Mr. Smyth and Ms. Huckle (Ukulele) and Mr. Leach (D and D). Thanks to Ms. Smith, Ms. Huckle, Mr. Fong and Mr. Smyth for working with our students on volleyball. We have also had three Burnaby Parks and Rec after-school groups start in the past couple of weeks. Slowly, we are seeing the return of activities for our students, being mindful of all the necessary COVID – 19 safety protocols, of course. I know students are enjoying these activities. My thanks to the staff for sponsoring them as well.

I hope that everyone had a Happy Hallowe'en. As you can see from the photo, many staff members enjoyed dressing up on Friday. Lots of students did as well this year.






