- I also sent Chad the full slide deck presentation from the SD on the budget process, which largely the same presentation as the one available on the SD website: https://burnabyschools.ca/wp-content/uploads/2022/04/Public-Budget-Presentation-April-12-2022.pdf (from the April 12 public meeting). Tonight the board is meeting to finalize the 2022/23. Sadly, it'll be another year of cuts. But hopefully they won't be too deep. Parents were given an opportunity to provide feedback on the proposed adjustments via webform until 10 AM this morning (hence my email last night).
- Of note I don't anticipate that all of the proposed budget adjustments will be included in the finalized budget as the SD still has a sizable projected fund balance (reserve) of approx. \$10.2M that will mitigate budget impacts over the short term. However, the funds will quickly run out if some adjustments aren't made account for the shortfall of funds projected over the next three years.
- For the previous DPAC meeting in February (yes, there were two DPAC meetings since our last SCCC meeting), we received a presentation on mental health literacy from the SD's Principal of Safe and Caring Schools Nick Christofides. Mental health literacy is part of the District's strategic plan as it leads to healthy outcomes.
