- All after hours user groups must apply through the district's Facility Rentals department

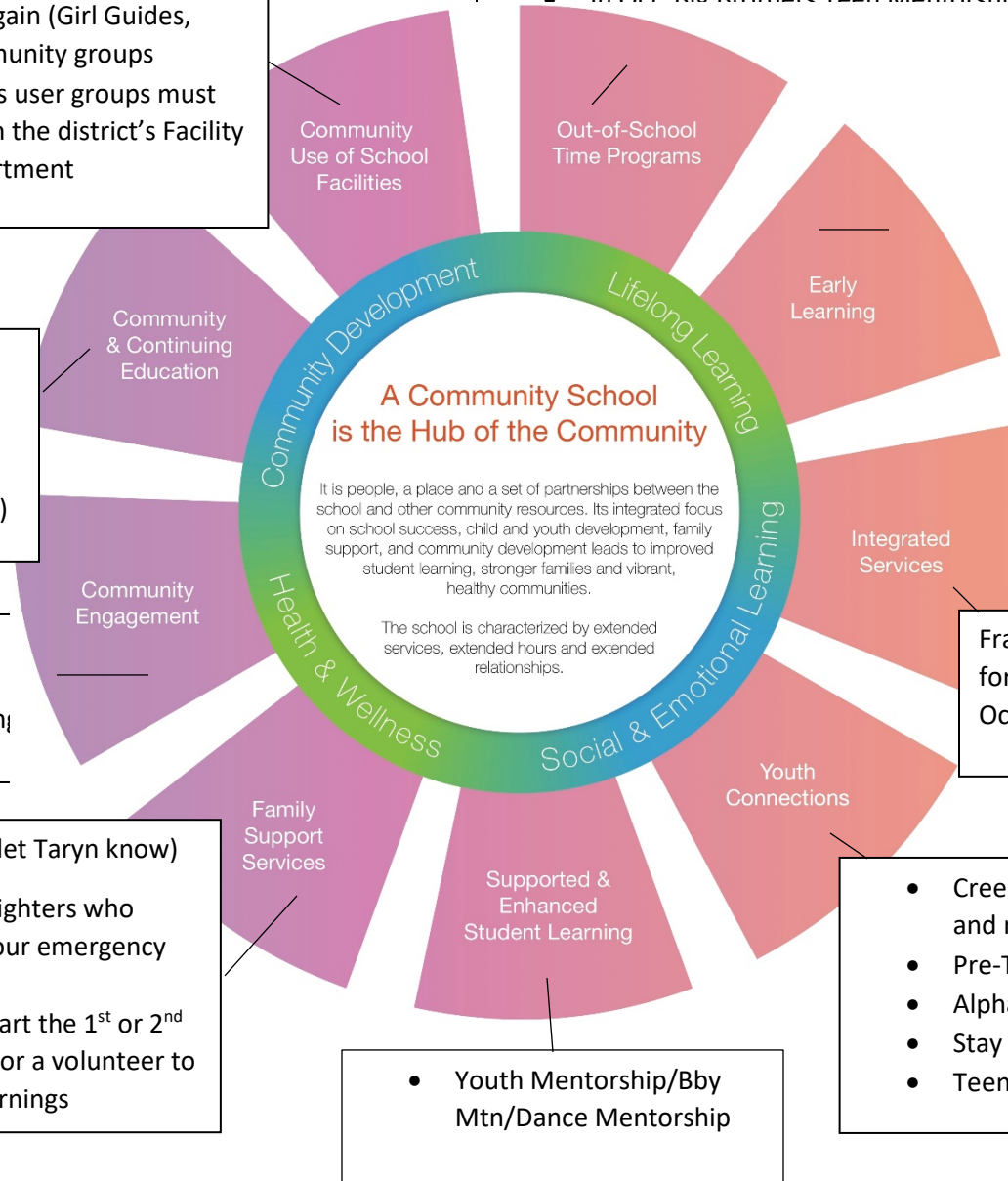
- Programs running @ Stoney:
